

## *Post Wedding Checklist Guide*

You're married and potentially changed your name! If you thought planning your wedding was fun, just wait until you fill out a million forms to update your information everywhere. This guide is here to help make it a bit easier for you. You may need your certified copy of the marriage license (note: This cannot be a copy of the one signed the day of the wedding, it must be the official copy that is sent to you once processed.)

### **Government Agencies:**

**Social Security Card:** For more information visit [www.ssa.gov](http://www.ssa.gov)

**Drivers License/DMV:** Including drivers license, car title, and registration. For more information visit <http://dmv.ny.gov>

**Voter Registration:** Can be done at DMV at the same time you file for a new license.

**Passport:** Visit <https://travel.state.gov/content/travel/en/passports/have-passport.html> as the forms vary based upon how much time is left on the passport.

**W-2 IRS Documents:** IRS change of address form [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov)

Now that the important government stuff is out of the way, there can be a number of personal records you may need to update as well such as:

### **Your Financial and Banking Records**

Bank Accounts, Lockbox, MoneyMarket, etc

Investments/Stock Plans

Retirement Plan (401k, IRA, etc.)

Wills

Vehicle Loans/Lease

Mortgagees

Credit Cards

Department Store Accounts

### **Personal Records**

Post Office Change of Address

Vehicle Title

Property Tax Record

Insurance information (Auto/Home/Life Insurance, etc)

Medical Records

Military/Academic Records or ID

Utilities: Phone/Electric/Gas/Oil etc

Cell Phone

Subscriptions (Amazon/Netflix/Go Fresh etc)

There may be other records you need to update but this should get you started in the right direction.
